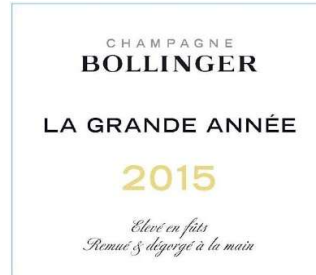

BOLLINGER

La Grande Année 2015

An incredibly special wine from a historic family-owned producer.



Bollinger was founded in 1829 and it is still family owned today, which not at all common in Champagne. The modern turning point of the house can be credited to Elisabeth (Lily) Bollinger who brought Bollinger to the world stage and was even nicknamed “the first lady of France” by Chicago’s American in 1961.

Meaning the ‘Great Year’, La Grande Année is only produced in exceptional vintages. Each bottle is aged for ten years before release and all of the riddling and disgorging is done by hand, in the traditional manner. Bollinger are one of few producer to still vinify in oak, an ancient method that helps develop aromas of great finesse.

The vintage 2015 was the hottest on record, which means that there was very little or no reason to spray for fungus. Due to the semi-drought conditions the yield was about 20% lower than average but the grapes were of above average quality. All of this means that 2015 is being ‘hailed as one of the vintages of the century’ in terms of quality and potential. On the nose you get hints of russet apples, Mirabelle plums with subtle notes of blackcurrant and vanilla. The rounded and generous palate shows Mirabelle plum jam with gorgeous notes of chocolate and citrus fruits, all supported by delicate bubbles.

VILLA SALETTA

A story spanning centuries

The estate has been owned by just four families throughout its history with documented winemaking traditions going back to 980AD. Beginning with the Gambacorta family in the 14th century, then notably the Riccardi family, bankers to the powerful house of Medici, then the Castelli Family, and lastly in 2000 to the Hands family. By then the estate had almost entirely fallen to ruin, however they saw the potential to combine traditional Tuscan techniques and modern technology, but always grounded in the heritage of the estate.

Spice, toasted oak and aromas of berries, liquorice and violets lead to a full palate with a deliciously jammy aftertaste of ripe red berries. A modern Bordeaux style blend of 55% Cabernet Franc and 45% Cabernet Sauvignon that boasts an impressive finish.

Aromas of leather, tobacco, ripe red fruit and quinine. The palate is savoury, full and ample with silky tannins and a long and persistent finish, making this wine a bold expression of the estate's terroir and showcases Sangiovese at its best.

980AD - MAGNUM

This multi-award-winning wine was recently awarded decanter Best in Show. A rich nose with aromas of cherries, raspberries, blueberries, cassis and wild forest fruits. The palate adds black pepper, vanilla, liquorice, and rosemary. Elegant, with velvety tannins with a very long finish.

These wines have been produced by David Landini, General Manager and Head Winemaker of Villa Saletta. A native Tuscan, who studied both viticulture and oenology in Florence and has become recognized as one of Italy's rising wine talents.

In March 2025 David was announced as one of the 100 best winemakers in the world by Drinks Business. With a clear focus on sustainability and working with nature to create incredible wines that reflect both the terroir and reflect modern tastes with a nod towards history and tradition.

Juicy and playful, with plum, sour cherry, and wild berry notes. A single varietal of Canaiolo, which is Tuscany's best kept secret. Provides fresh and savoury notes with a touch of Mediterranean herbs. Pairs with pasta, chargrilled meats, or enjoyed on its own.

I think biodiversity is the most important factor to improve our environment and the quality of a vineyard, and then a wine. There is a series of activities that need to be managed like a musical orchestra: introducing antagonistic insects, planting meadows with reblooming varieties that increase soil fertility, special green manure mixtures, total reduction of chemicals, meticulous improvement of each step of the process, planting forests in the valley bottoms to thermoregulate the macro-environment, avoiding monocultures and being respectful in the winery, producing and using renewable energy. I am proud to combine all these and other activities.

SPARKLING WINE

FitzRoy is an Anglo-Norman name originally meaning "son of the king" (from the French Fils de Roi). In many cases it was given to an illegitimate son or daughter of the king to mark their royal parent. Fitz is made in the method used to produce Prosecco, and therefore cannot call themselves English Sparkling Wine, so they chose a name that seemed fitting.

Musar is situated 15 kilometres north of Beirut. From 1975 to 1990, it was ravaged by civil war, but incredibly, only two vintages were missed, largely thanks to the great Serge Hochar. This seductive white is a blend of Obaideh and Merwah and portrays a palate of ripe white fruits, citrus and dried fruits.

The mountain of Hemel-en-Aarde in the Walker Bay rather romantically translates as Heaven and Earth. Voted number 4 in the Worlds Best Vineyard Awards 2023, Creation are part of the Pebbles Project, a charity designed to reach and care for the children of vineyard workers that focuses on 5 points; education, health, safety, nutrition and community.

ROSÉ

The popularity of rosé has rocketed in recent years with Provence in the south of France leading the way. Mostly made with skin contact during fermentation, this indicates it possibly being the oldest style of wine in the world.

Pinot Noir at its cool climate best. Michel Guillard and his sister Odette took over the winery in 1979 from their parents who had run it for two decades. Unlike many of their neighbours in Gevrey-Chambertin, the domain was established by Michel's grandmother, Jeanne Lyonnet, who worked as a maid in the village. She worked hard and saved enough money to buy her first few vines in 1913, which marked the beginning of the Domaine.
