Dog friendly


You can even share your experience with your canine companion as we are proud to be a dog-friendly hotel.

WALKS

From open countryside and woodland wanders to gentle sloping strolls and scenic vistas, there's a trail for everyone.

Lenham walk - 5.7 miles loop

Enjoy this walk with picturesque views of Kent Downs. Encounter a beautiful mix of woodland with bluebells on the forest floor and open fields. It is perfect for seeing wildlife and has enough variety for everyone to enjoy.

Harrietsham trail - 5.9 mile loop

Although Harrietsham lies along the A20, it's not long before you are out of the village and away from the traffic. The route offers excellent views of the surrounding countryside from the North Downs.

Hucking Estate Landscape trail - 2.4 mile circular


Hucking Estate sits within the Kent Downs Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty and is a beautiful mix of woodland and grassland. Enjoy the abundance of wildflowers on display and the stunning views across the Weald of Kent.

Pluckley and Little Chart - 4.3 mile circular

Feeling brave? This walk takes you through stunning fields and orchards surrounding England's most haunted village.

Leeds Castle and Kingswood walk - 5.2 miles circular

Explore the stunning grounds of this 19th century castle and former residence of Catherine of Aragon. There are 500 acres of beautiful parkland, open water, and formal gardens to explore on well-laid-out walking paths.

Port Lympne Reserve - 21 miles away




<u>Howletts Wild Animal Park</u> - 24 miles away

Mote Park - 12 miles away

Covering over 450 acres, Mote Park is home to a variety of natural features such as grassland, woodland, rivers and a 30 acre lake. The park is home to a number of mature trees, creating a beautiful, tranquil landscape.

McArthurGlen's Ashford Designer Outlet - 13 miles away

Westgate Gardens - 20 miles away

The beautifully landscaped Westgate Gardens will inspire visitors of all ages, whether you are seeking a gentle stroll over lunchtime or are escaping the hustle and bustle of city life. The River Great Stour runs through the centre of the park.

Whitstable - 23 miles away

Enjoy some of the beautiful, romantic coastal walks that Whitstable has to offer. Oysters and other delicacies from the sea can be enjoyed at the local restaurants and pubs or taken home from the fresh fish market at the harbour

The White Cliffs of Dover - 35 miles away

The White Cliffs of Dover are perhaps most famous as an iconic landmark. As well as being a symbol of home and wartime defence, the cliffs have much more to offer with stunning walks and serene views.





HISTORICAL

Step back in time and uncover Kent's rich heritage and cultural legacy.

Leeds Castle - 5 miles away

Visitors never forget their first breath-taking glimpse of Leeds Castle, which rises majestically from the moat as it has done for over 900 years. It has been a Norman stronghold, the private property of six of England's medieval queens, and even a palace used by Henry VIII.

Godinton House & Gardens - 11 miles away

This remarkable country house, nestled in the heart of Kent, dates back to the 14th century. Tours of the house are led by expert guides unravelling the 600 years of history and revealing an excellent country house collection of furniture, art, porcelain and curios.

Canterbury Cathedral - 20 miles away

Visit Canterbury Cathedral to come face to face with enchanting and inspiring architecture and history, which attracts people from all over the world.

The Historic Dockyard Chatham - 20 miles away

This remarkable place celebrates Great Britain's magnificent maritime past and its command of the oceans from the heyday of the age of sail and beyond.

<u>Lullingstone Castle</u> - 30 miles away

Lullingstone Castle is one of England's oldest family estates, dating back to the time of Domesday. The present Manor House and Gatehouse were built in 1497 and have been home to the same family ever since. Henry VIII was known to have been a regular visitor.

Dover Castle - 34 miles away

Rising above the famous White Cliffs high above the Channel, Dover Castle is an icon of England. This mighty fortress has been the site of royal intrigue and epic sieges and was at the centre of the crucial effort to evacuate hundreds of thousands of Allied troops from the beach of Dunkirk.
